Rosebud Irrigation has just completed another major project, this time at Trueman's Rd Golf Range, with great results.

The job involved conversion of the manual irrigation system to an automatic pop-up system operated by a Rainbird controller, using Hunter I31 sprinklers.

The system consists of 11 zones, using

bore water that's drawn by a submersible pump. Rosebud Irrigation also installed a tank and pump system for everyday washing off golf balls and equipment cleaning.

Plan now for a green summer

Happily for all of us, June and July brought good rain ... but we're not out of the woods yet!

It's a great time to plan for more capacity. Don't just watch your tanks overflow! Store this precious rain and use it through the coming summer.

There's lots of learning from the El Niño event and drought of the past 10 years, it's a good time to adequately plan for your future water needs. Talk to us about rain sensors too. These automatically cut off your irrigation system when there's sufficient coming from the sky.

We can give your watering systems and bore a check over before summer. We'll adjust settings and controller programs as well as check your entire system for performance and coverage so you can enjoy a green summer.

Some other ways to make sure your garden looks great into early next year:

- Programming controller not to



overwater. Plants will adapt to the given water requirement, so stringent programming helps 'train' them. As an approximate guide between now and October- November, twice a week watering would be sufficient: 15 minutes on the lawn, 10 minutes on the garden beds.

- Apply fertiliser in August/early Sept.
- Apply insecticide and fungicide in August/September for your roses and other annuals.
- Keep up the above through October.

Resetting your controller

Going into spring storm season, we're more susceptible to surges. Disconnect the back up battery and press the reset button. If you want to protect against power surges, call us. We'll organise for a power surge protector to be installed on the unit or on the house.

Keep ants out

Apply Baygon ant powder at the start of spring, around BUT NOT IN your pump switching system, controller, powerpoints and main switch box.
